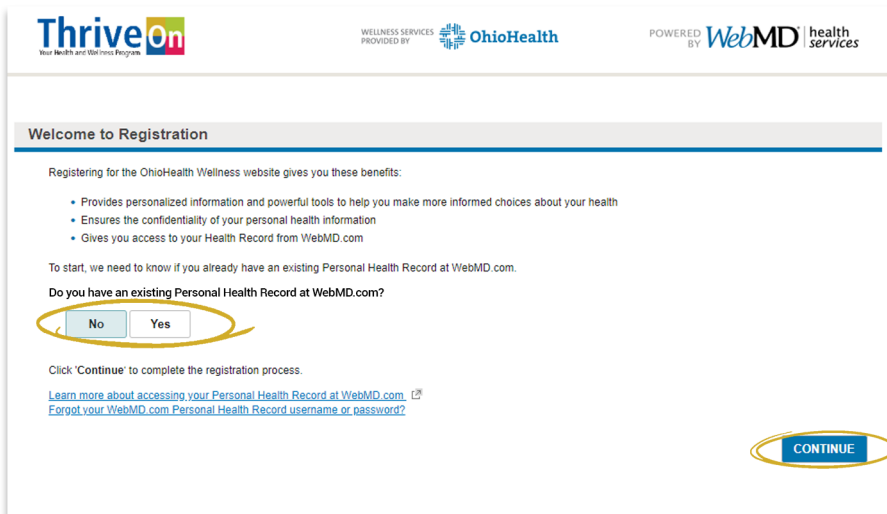
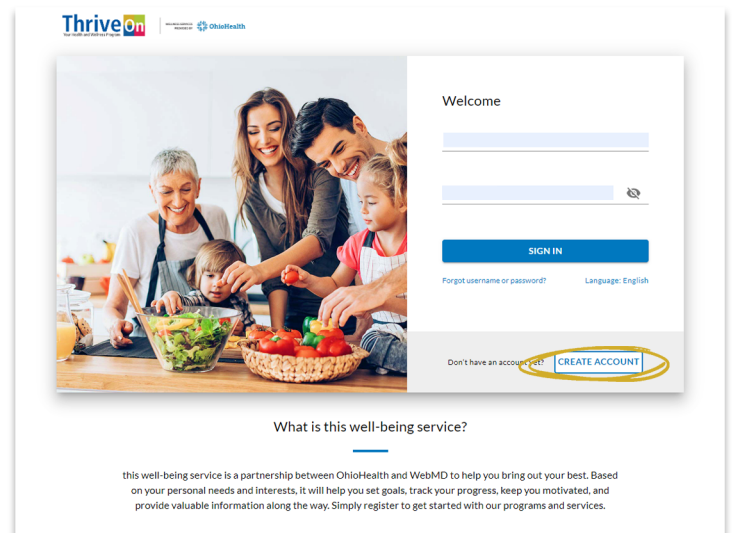


Portal Registration Instructions

On the home page, click **“Create Account”**

Portal Registration Instructions



On the registration screen you will enter your registration ID in the first box under Authentication and Security Information. Your registration ID is the first 7 letters of your last name followed by your DOB in mm/dd/yyyy format. **For example, Andrew Smith with a DOB of January 8, 1933 would have a registration ID of smith01081933.**

Next, create a username and password that fit the criteria. This username and password is what you will use to log-in going forward. Continue to fill in all of the required information (i.e. birthdate, email, etc.).
