General Well-Being

2nd.MD*: Questions about a medical concern? 2nd.MD can help you determine if a second opinion is right for you. Call (866) 269-3534 to connect with an expert to confirm a new or existing diagnosis, discuss an ongoing condition, or explore alternative treatment options.

ASK YOUR UNITED HEALTHCARE HEALTH ENGAGEMENT NURSE: Your UHC Health Engagement Nurses help you understand health conditions and partner with you to provide support, encouragement and connection to resources and benefits. They may reach out to you to offer their services or you can contact them at (614) 525-6773.

FRANKLIN COUNTY 5K & THRIVEON CHALLENGE: Each year ThriveOn hosts a 5k walk/run for employees and eligible dependents (spouses/ domestic partners and children). Information is typically made available in June. Visit runsignup.com/franklincounty5k to learn more.

HEALTH COACHING: Work one-on-one with a health coach to address a variety of needs, including exercise, nutrition, tobacco cessation, weight management and more. Visit fccThriveOn.com to get started.

MEDICAL VIRTUAL VISITS*: Virtual Visits connects you with physicians 24/7 through your mobile device or computer. Good for after-hours care for a wide range of non-emergency services such as cold/flu, UTIs, diarrhea and pinkeye. Prescriptions can be called into your local pharmacy. To schedule an appointment, log in to myUHC.com.

MYGENETICSCREEN*: Genetic testing can be used to identify an individual's risk for developing a certain disease. Testing is available to all members age 18 years and up for the following conditions:

- Hereditary Breast and Ovarian Cancer Syndrome (BRCA1, BRCA2)
- Colorectal cancer (Lynch Syndrome)
- Hereditary high cholesterol (familial hypercholesterolemia)

ACUPUNCTURE*: Acupuncture is a covered service for any diagnosis under the health plan. In-network only. Limited to 15 visits per year. \$20 copay per visit. For more information, call **(877) 440-5983**.

CANCERBRIDGE: Have you or a loved one been diagnosed with cancer? CancerBridge provides information specific to your cancer, expert cancer navigation and insights into treatment options. CHIROPRACTIC CARE*: Receive up to 25 visits per year. \$20 copay per visit. First three visits at \$0 copay for newly diagnosed back pain. No out-of-network coverage. Call **(877) 440-5983** to learn more.

DIABETES CONDITION MANAGEMENT*: If you have type 2 diabetes, learn how to manage it successfully with UHC's Diabetes Condition Management. MAINTENANCE MEDICATIONS*: 100% coverage of medications in the following categories. Prescription required.

- Tier 1 & Tier 2 glycosides, anti-blood pressure, anti-diabetic, anti-cholesterol, anti-anginal, and anti-coagulant medications.
- Diabetic supplies, injectable insulin, blood glucose monitors, and continuous glucose monitors (CGM).

MASSAGE THERAPY*: Receive up to 15 in-network visits per year. \$20 copay per visit. For more information call **(877) 440-5983**.

SPECIALIST MANAGEMENT SOLUTIONS (SMS)*: End-to-end support from orthopedic nurses, for a full-range of musculoskeletal conditions. SMS nurses discuss treatment options and how your benefits are applied, provide holistic advocacy from pre to post-surgery and assist in selection of high quality providers. Incentives are available (\$500), if certain surgical procedures are performed at Centers of Excellence facilities. Call **(877) 440-5983** for more information.

WEIGHT LOSS MEDICATION*: Available if you meet specific clinical criteria and have a prescription. Subject to the normal copay.

WEIGHT WATCHERS CLINIC*: WeightWatchers' comprehensive weight management program pairs clinically-proven medications with access to board-certified clinicians, Registered Dietitians, fitness coaches, and a Care Coordinator - to help members lose weight. Starting this April, enroll in WeightWatchers to access the WeightWatchers Clinic at WW.com/fcc. If you are taking a GLP-1 for weight loss or are planning to, you are strongly encouraged to engage with the WeightWatchers Clinic.

Physical Well-Being

GYM MEMBERSHIP REIMBURSEMENT: Visit a gym or utilize your at-home membership at least 8 days per month and receive up to \$50. Be reimbursed 50% of your costs, up to \$25/month for utilizing your membership 4-7 days per month. Visit gymreimbursement.franklincountyohio.gov to learn more.

PREVENTIVE CARE*: Many routine preventive services are covered 100% with a \$0 copay including dental and vision exams, flu and COVID-19 vaccines, mammograms, well-woman exams, pap smears, skin cancer screenings, annual physicals and colonoscopies. Visit myUHC.com to find a provider.

PREVENTIVE MEDICATIONS*: Certain preventive medications are covered 100%, including contraceptives and HIV PrEP. Visit BeWell.franklincountyohio.gov for more information.

TOBACCO CESSATION PRODUCTS*: 100% coverage for over-the-counter and prescription nicotine replacement products. Prescription required. Tobacco cessation coaching is also available at fccThriveOn.com.

Family Forming and Women's Health

MATERNITY SUPPORT PROGRAM (MSP)*: If you have a baby on the way, MSP is here to help with personalized support including access to maternity nurses, educational resources and specialized services for you and your baby – before, during and after pregnancy. MENOPAUSE HORMONE REPLACEMENT THERAPY*: 100% coverage of Tier 1 and Tier 2 estrogen and estrogen-combos. Prescription required.
