### Ask for Help to Fight Addiction

Most of us have adjusted to our new normal following the global pandemic. We're optimistic and hopeful as we look forward. But for some, drug and alcohol addiction - fueled by the weight of the pandemic - continues to cloud any sense of hope.

If your personal or professional life has become unmanageable due to substance abuse, you're not alone. The Optum Substance Use Disorder Helpline (1-855-780-5955) is here to help. This service is confidential, free-to-you, and available 24/7.

You are unique. Your circumstances differ from others. That's why it's incredibly important for a treatment advocate to:

- **Listen.** Take time to fully understand your personal situation and guide or work with you to determine next steps most helpful to you.
- **Share**. Discuss appropriate treatment options and providers available.
- Schedule. If you and your advocate decide it would be helpful, they'll arrange a face-to-face clinical evaluation for you by a trusted licensed substance use treatment provider - usually within 24 hours.

Next, your individual provider will work with you to create a personalized treatment strategy - designed just for you. Depending on your unique needs, a credentialed treatment center can provide clinically appropriate care. Your provider can also assign a dedicated care advocate to you and your family (if you find it helpful) for ongoing support for up to six months.

# Get Your Free Biometric Screening (and Get Paid for It!)

One of the many perks to your ThriveOn wellness program is a free annual biometric screening (offered onsite through OhioHealth and available at your doctor's office). If you haven't taken advantage of your 2022 biometric screening yet, <a href="Iog into your ThriveOn portal">Iog into your ThriveOn portal</a> and click **Onsite Biometric Screening** to find and book an appointment.

#### What's a Biometric Screening?

A biometric screening is a clinical screening that's done to measure certain physical characteristics. It can be used to assess your:

- body mass index
- hemoglobin A1c
- blood sugar levels
- plasma triglyceride levels
- LDL ("the bad") cholesterol levels
- HDL ("the good") cholesterol levels
- blood pressure

The goal of a biometric screening is to give a snapshot of your health and alert you to any changes in your health status. Your <u>Health Engagement Nurses</u> can also help you understand your numbers and discuss helpful options for improving your health.

Wellness Your Way: Getting a biometric screening can earn you a \$200 Biometric Screening incentive through ThriveOn's Wellness Your Way program.

 IMPORTANT: If you choose to complete a biometric screening at your doctor's office, make sure you <u>print and complete the Primary</u> <u>Care Provider Biometric Instructions and Form.</u>
 You are responsible for making sure that the form is submitted by December 31, 2022.



## An Ounce of Prevention: The NEW! COVID-19 Bivalent Booster

To help you make an informed decision about your health and the new COVID-19 Bivalent vaccine booster, our partners at OhioHealth have the following to share.

#### About the Bivalent booster:

- It is a one-dose booster.
- There are two options: Moderna for ages 18+ and Pfizer for ages 12+
- This replaces all current boosters for anyone ages 12+. This is now the ONLY booster that will be administered to anyone 12+.
- Anyone age 12 and older can receive the booster if it's been at least two months since they last received a COVID-19 shot (either primary series or first or second booster).
